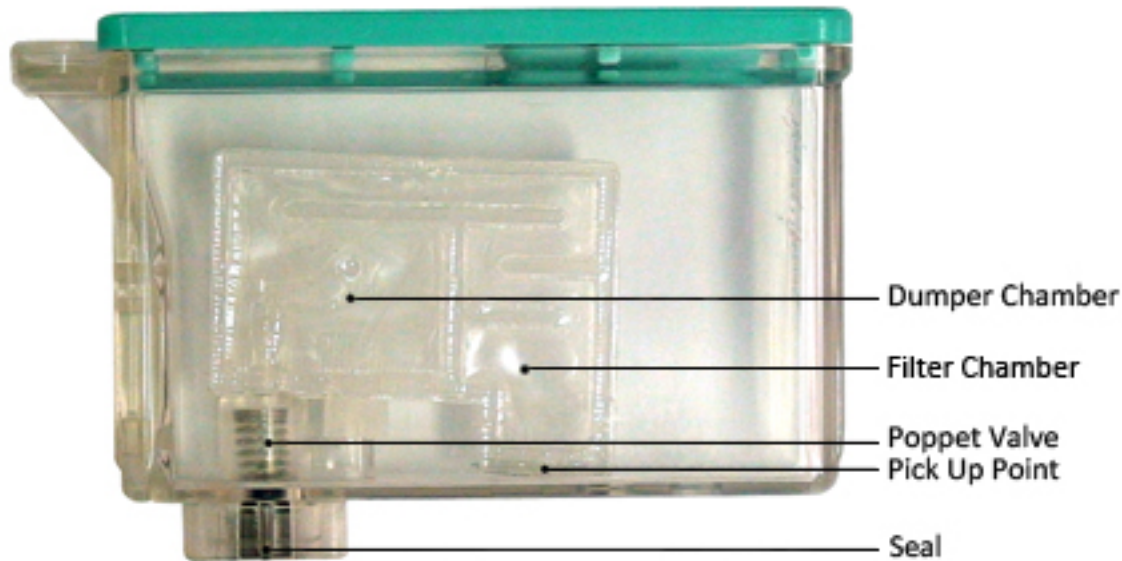




Too Good To Be True - With SpringJet Spongless Ink Cartridge, refilling is a breeze. All you have to do is remove the rubber plug on the top of the cartridge, inject ink until full, put the rubber plug back in place, and you are ready to go. No more fighting with the foam trying to get a good nozzle pattern. These cartridge will print perfect every time and can be refilled over and over again. Just what we always wanted.



How it works - When the printer requires ink, it is pulled into the *filter chamber*, from the *pick up point*, then through the *damper chambers* and down past the *poppet valve* and into the printer.

Important - The ink in the SpringJet Cartridge can not be left emptied - it will cause nozzle blocked or damaged.

Image Maker recommend user to refill ink when ink in springjet cartridge is half or at least 25% ink left in the cartridge.

When the ink is half - an "ink is running low" pop up message will be prompt to the user. Please **refill the cartridge untill full**. Which can **prevent the air entering**

and **the ink dried making the nozzle blocked or damaged.**
